Obviously there must be a considerable discount on the current rate for potable water at up to 20% above the rate charged by SA Water! Also we have had no notification about the quality of the water to be provided- will there be any treatment at all or will it continue to bypass the treatment phase? Clearly this will affect any filters we may be able to use. Removing the encumbrance will also remove the necessity for Cape Jaffa Anchorage Essential Services to provide the service. Many of the lots in this development are too small to effectively store enough water to be self sufficient (providing their tank water is actually potable) so they remain dependent upon CJAES honouring their obligation contained in clause 9 of the encumbrance. What happens if they decide to hand in their licence?
