I am writing to object most strenuously about 'Cape Jaffa Anchorage Essential Services Pty Ltd' (CJAES) application to have Cape Jaffa water supply being downgraded to non drinking water.

I originally bought my block and eventually built a house on it at [REDACTED] Cape Jaffa with the belief that they were going to supply Potable water to every property including mine.

I would never have bought this property if I could not drink the water from the mains tap or even clean my teeth in it.

The contract we all signed states :-

Clause 9.1 Subject to Clause 9.2, the Encumbrance agrees with the owner to procure the availability of the following services for the benefit of the Land:

(a) reticulated potable water; and

(b) sewage discharge and effluent treatment

Clause 9.2 The Encumbrancee shall use reasonable endeavours to ensure that the Services are available to the Land at all times and if, for any reason beyond the Encumbrancee's reasonable control, the Services are not available to the Land at any time, the Encumbrancee shall use reasonable endeavours to make them available again as soon as practicable..

A lot of people have bought land and built homes at Cape Jaffa with this promise in mind and would be very upset if the reneged on this.

I really would hope that you would side with the Landowners here and make CJAES do whatever is necessary to get our drinking water back to normal.
