Business SA is pleased to provide feedback to the Essential Services Commission of South Australia with regards to SA Water service standards performance for the regulatory period of 1 July 2013-30 June 2016.

Business SA has reviewed the service standards and is pleased that a base level of service, through data collection and monitoring, is being established so that future movements can be accurately measured in the future.

Business SA is also pleased with the approach taken, the "best endeavours" method. Whilst all SA Water issues that customers have should be resolved as soon as possible, it is vital that where issues haven't been able to be resolved in a timely manner (within the service standards), that there is a mechanism for addressing how SA Water went about using their best endeavours to fix the issue.

It is unfortunate, as the Commission notes, that there is a misalignment between the service standards for metropolitan Adelaide and rural and regional

South Australia. Business SA would expect that in the future SA Water is able to deliver more comparable service standards to rural and regional South Australia as a major part of the State's economy is outside the metropolitan area.

Overall, Business SA is happy with the targets set, and we look forward to continued engagement with SA Water through the SA Water Business Customer Advisory Group.
