RE: Review of the solar feed-in tariff premium

The Clean Energy Council welcomes the opportunity to respond to the Essential Services Commission of South Australia's Draft Determination on the Review of the Solar Feed-in Tariff Premium.

We are pleased to note that you have recognised competition issues and have recommended against deregulation of feed-in tariffs in 2014. We welcome your decision to implement a formal price-monitoring regime with a view to further reviewing your regulatory approach prior to 2015.

As part of your review we would urge you to consider regulating for a time-varying feed-in tariff, which is the approach being contemplated by Victoria's Essential Services Commission. We strongly urge you to consider the merits of a technology-neutral, time-varying feed-in tariff that is at least equal to the value of that energy in the relevant electricity market and the relevant electricity network it feeds into, taking into account the time of day during which energy is exported. This should include a payment at critical peak periods commensurate with the prevailing wholesale electricity price at that time.
