Further to our submission to the draft report our solar farm proposals have continued to progress and provide the following summary update.

Renewable Energy Solutions on the Eyre Peninsula-Solar Farm Development

Local Partner;

Eye Energy Systems, locally owned and operated solar installation company based in Port Lincoln providing:

- Off grid power and systems integration
- Local development support
- Local council, community and industry consultation

Developer;

Sunpact, Australian developer of PV projects existing assets under ownership include:

- 1.00MW Karratha Airport solar farm with 500kW battery
- 2.30MW Mt Majura solar farm
- 11.0MW Williamsdale solar farm

DNSP;

Application requests for all sites have been submitted and are progressing through SAPN large site generator connection process.

Land, Site, Design;

Eye Energy Systems and Sunpact hold options on four substantial parcels of land across Eyre Peninsula and have had extensive consultation with DNSP.

Sunpact and Eye Energy Systems now have 2 sites under development on Eyre Peninsula with options to lease/purchase land secured for Wudinna and Cleve.



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Both sites will be designed with:

- Single axis tracking – to flatten the production curve throughout the day
- Storage capability for future deployment

Overview of Economic Activity;

- Early enquiry submitted to SAPN for all sites in December 2016
- SAPN offer to connect Wudinna and Cleve targeted for November 2017
- 60MWp of solar PV capacity across both sites
- Combined generating capacity ~120GWh p.a.
- More than \$100m of economic activity generated in the region
- More than 100 jobs created at peak activity
- More than 10 full time jobs in regional areas
- Opportunities for ongoing regional skills development, capacity building and tourism

Opportunities for innovation;

- Battery storage
- Black start capacity
- Voltage regulation and grid support services

Financial close expected by Jan 2018, with commencement on site in Feb 2018
