Subject: Tatiara Seeds – Generation License Surrender

Adam,

The Energy Project are assisting Tatiara Seeds in reviewing requirements imposed under their Electricity Generation License issued by the Essential Services Commission of South Australia on 23 April 2020.

The Tatiara Seeds Generation license includes a solar PV power station with nameplate capacity of 118kVA provided by 4x27kVA and 1x10kVA Solar Inverters.

Upon our review, Tatiara Seeds have determined that they wish to cease gaining a financial reward for energy exported from the electricity generation system. It is proposed that this is achieved via Tatiara Seed's current energy retail offer [REDACTED] with an export/feed in tariff set to 0c/kWh.

As a result, we write to the Commission on behalf of Tatiara Seeds to request to surrender Tatiara Seed's Electricity Generation License per Section 29 of the Electricity Act 1996.

In line with Clause 29.3 and with consideration for the relatively small size of the generating system, we request that the commission consider shortening the period of notice to 28 days from issue of this letter.

In considering this notice for surrender and noting the relatively short period the license has been held we also request that the requirement for annual compliance reporting for Financial Year FY19/20 for the License be removed.
