Our Situation

On the information supplied it hasn't answered our particular situation. We are not average users, and in fact are probably one of the highest in the estate. We paid \$1,984 last year and have paid as much as \$2,580 in past years. Therefore to get an indication of how we will be affected by the change we will need to know the breakup of the intended new fees .It is noted that our current contract allows only a maximum of 5% increase in any one year if SA Water is not used as the Rate Calculation. Will this be null and void once the new decision is made ?

Revenue Calculation

We are also interested in how the maximum revenue cap of \$283,337 has been calculated. With the regulatory 6 Quarter period being 1/4/2021 to 30/9/2022, and not a Financial Year ,has the Calculation been based on 4 of the quarters being lower usage ones for most of us , and 2 of them higher for a percentage of clients (summer December 2012 and January 2022) ? This would arrive at the Revenue expected for the period in question.

Who Decides on the Final Water Rate Charges
