

**Robusto Investments Pty Ltd –delivery of drinking water to Mt. Compass**

Further to my submission dated 26/11/2020 I have a couple more comments to make .

I note that in setting prices Robusto must comply with and not exceed the maximum Revenue set. With many variants I would imagine that this will be very hard to meet, particularly if the supplier decides to estimate the KL rate on the maximum allowed.

If at the end of the last quarter of the Regulatory Period the consumption takes the figure over that allowed, will the consumer's rates be adjusted down to achieve the required maximum. Secondly, if the maximum figure is not achieved at the end of the last quarter, does the supplier have the right to charge more at the end of last quarter of the Regulatory Period to achieve the maximum allowed? I believe that on past experience our supplier will try and achieve as much as possible out of residents from the formula proposed.

In regards to the cost per KL to be charged, I am a firm proponent of having only one rate, not a tiered rate as at present. This would make estimates much easier to calculate and simplify the quarter calculation for the supplier . I note that this is the method charged by Lightsview Re-Water Supply Co. Pty Ltd in a recent submission. Of course their situation is quite different to ours, and I would expect that their rate of \$3.23 per KL can only be used as a guideline.
