**re: Review of the Electricity Transmission Code – 2023-2028 – Draft Decision**

ElectraNet appreciates the Commission's timely conduct of the review of the Electricity Transmission Code.

On 29 March 2021 you released a draft decision which concluded that the current reliability standards under the Code remain appropriate, and proposed minor amendments to remove the Leigh Creek coal exit point from the Code and clarify the notification requirements for unplanned interruptions. ElectraNet supports these changes and has no further comments on the draft decision.

ElectraNet notes the ongoing increase in reverse power flows into the transmission network from the distribution network as the level of distributed energy resources continues to grow (such as rooftop solar PV). We are keen to engage with the Commission on the treatment of reverse flows and the potential impact on customer reliability for future revisions of the Electricity Transmission Code.
