

NOTICE OF VARIATION OF EXEMPTION

PURSUANT TO SECTION 80(3) OF THE ELECTRICITY ACT 1996

- 1. On 29 November 2019, the Essential Services Commission (Commission), with the approval of the Minister for Energy and Mining, granted participants enrolled in the Australian Energy Market Operator's (AEMO) Virtual Power Plant Demonstrations Program (VPP Demonstration Program) an exemption from the requirement to hold an electricity generation licence, as required by Part 3 of the *Electricity Act 1996 (SA)*. This exemption is subject to conditions and originally granted for a fixed term expiring on the conclusion of the VPP Demonstration Program or on the 30 June 2021 (whichever was the earlier).
- 2. Pursuant to s80(3) of the *Electricity Act 1996*, the Commission has determined to vary the exemption by:
 - a. Extending the term of the exemption such that it now expires on 30 June 2023.
 - b. Specifying that the exemption applies to the following entities (exemptees) who are enrolled as participants in the VPP Demonstration Program:
 - i. AGL South Australia Pty Limited (ACN 091 105 092)
 - ii. Energy Locals Pty Ltd (ACN 606 408 979)
 - iii. Simply Energy (ACN 269 241 237)
 - iv. Shine Hub Pty Ltd (ACN 614 356 302)
 - c. All other existing terms of the original exemption remain in effect (unless revoked or varied earlier in accordance with the requirements of the *Electricity Act 1996 (SA)*).
