



Water Industry Act 2012

Variation to Exemption

1. On 14 February 2018, the Essential Services Commission (**Commission**), with the approval of the Minister for Water and the River Murray, granted Whyalla Golf Club Incorporated (ABN 95 769 034 135) an exemption from the application of Part 4 of the *Water Industry Act 2012* (**WI Act**), in relation to the retailing of water services.
2. Pursuant to section 108(4) of the WI Act, the Commission has made an administrative correction to the exemption by varying the location from Meadows, South Australia to Whyalla, South Australia, to reflect the correct location of the water retail services.
3. All existing conditions imposed on the exemption remain in effect and the exemption continues until revoked by the Commission or by operation of the law.

EXEMPTION

PURSUANT TO SECTION 108(1) OF THE WATER INDUSTRY ACT 2012

1. Pursuant to section 108(1) of the Water Industry Act 2012, the Essential Services Commission, with the approval of the Minister for Water and the River Murray, grants Whyalla Golf Club Incorporated (ABN 95 769 034 135) an exemption from the application of Part 4 of the Water Industry Act 2012 in relation to the retailing of water services in Meadows, South Australia.
2. The exemption continues until revoked by the Essential Services Commission or by operation of law.
3. Pursuant to section 108(3) of the Water Industry Act 2012, the Essential Services Commission has determined that, for the purposes of section 68 of the Water Industry Act 2012 Whyalla Golf Club Incorporated is to be treated as a 'water industry entity', as that term is defined in the Water Industry Act 2012.
4. The grant of this exemption from the requirement to hold a licence, pursuant to section 108(1) of the Water Industry Act 2012, is subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Prior to any changes occurring, Whyalla Golf Club Incorporated must inform both the Commission and the Office of the Technical Regulator in writing of any changes to the water operations undertaken, including, the cessation of supplying the service or the provision of additional water services, and submit to any additional assessments as required.
 - b. If directed by the Commission in writing, Whyalla Golf Club Incorporated is to participate in an Ombudsman Scheme.
 - c. Whyalla Golf Club Incorporated must provide to the Commission any information reasonably sought by the Commission from time to time.
