### Como Glasshouse No2 Pty Ltd - Surrender of Electricity Generation Licence

I refer to your letter dated 13 August 2024, in which Como Glasshouse No2 Pty Ltd (ACN 604 272 942) (**Como Glasshouse**), provided notice regarding the surrender of its electricity generation licence, currently authorising generation operations in Kournye.

Pursuant to section 29 of the *Electricity Act 1996*, notice must be given to the Essential Services Commission at least six months before the surrender is to take effect. The Commission may agree to shorten the required period.

Como Glasshouse has expressed its intention to take advantage of the temporary class exemption for sub-5MW generators, granted by the Commission on 24 November 2021, with the term of that exemption currently expiring on 30 November 2024. Accordingly, Como Glasshouse has requested that the standard six-month notice period for surrender be shortened.

Having regard to Como Glasshouse's request to surrender its licence, its representations that it understands that the exemption is time-limited and it may subsequently require a licence following the end of the exemption period, and that it remains obliged to provide regulatory reporting for 2024-25, I advise that the Commission has agreed to both the shorter timeframe and the surrender of Como Glasshouse's electricity generation licence, effective on and from 27 September 2024.
