I am writing in regards to "Ororoo water quality" supplied by S. A. Water to the township of Ororoo.

The water supplied by S. A. Water to Ororoo is of very poor quality and would only be used for human consumption as a last resort.

This water supply corrodes taps to the extent that they have to be replaced every few years. It cannot be used in hot water systems as it eats them out very quickly.

When used in toilet systems it forms a shale which wears the rubbers and they have to be replaced regularly and eventually the whole cistern has to be replaced.

Very few vegetables can be grown with the quality of this water being supplied by S. A. Water, and lawns struggle to survive on this water.

This is very notable as they are lush and green after a rain.

If a decent potable was supplied more homes would use the water and this would mean more income to S. A. Water.

If any member of the E. S. C. O. S. A. board had this quality of water connected to their property they would have something done about its quality.

I challenge the members of the E. S. C. O. S. A. board to spend a couple of days in Ororoo and only drink beverages made with water supplied by S. A. Water to Ororoo.
