ESCOSA's Water Regulatory Information Requirements for Intermediate and Minor Retailers – Water Industry Guideline No. 3 (WG3/01), Consultation Draft

Thank you for providing Council with the opportunity to provide comment on the above mentioned document. It is understood the Local Government Association Community Wastewater Management System Management Committee (on which Council has a representative) will be submitting a detailed response. Mindful of the LGACWMSMC response the following complementary comments are provided.

Mid Murray Council stands to be particularly affected by reporting/operational requirements as we have both CWMS (a proportionally large number for a rural Council) and water supply infrastructure predominantly located along the River Murray. Under current legislative requirements Council reports annually to the Department of Health and Ageing relating to operational performance. We have a dedicated CWMS Maintenance Advisory Committee that meets bi-annually to discuss finances and operational issues associated with CWMS and Council also has an obligation to meet the financial requirements of the Local Government Act.

## OP1.1 - Timeliness of response to telephone calls

Council is committed to assessing and improving service delivery standards however this requirement should be deleted as it is currently unrealistic and certainly unachievable.

## **OP1.2 – Customer complaints**

Mid Murray Council as it is suggested the majority of rural Councils, will struggle to meet this reporting requirement. It is possibly achievable but will impact on staff resources.

## OP3.1 & OP3.2 - Water and sewerage infrastructure reliability

Achievable but will have an impact on limited staff resources.
