I read with interest the "proposed retailer feed-in tariff 2015-16.

Sir, i believe that with retailers charging more and more for electricity that you have been influenced too much by the submissions of these retailers.

Many of us who have installed solar panels in an attempt to reduce this states reliance on non – renewable sources of power are not receiving a fair return on our investment.

Power companies are currently paying on average 7.2 cents per kilowatt hour from their own pockets, and charging over 31 cents per kilowatt hour for this same power.

I consider this profit for the power companies of over 300 percent to be immoral. You are considering lifting this profit margin to over 500 percent?

The state government has disclosed that their ideal is for an increased proportion of power generated by renewable sources to over 45 percent.

Your proposed feed in tariff will do nothing to further this aim, as people will not invest without adequate return.

I am very angry with power companies for their attitude towards existing clients, and your proposal for this feed in tariff can only be seen as a further insult to the people of this state, who are being faced with the highest prices for power in this country.
