I notice on page 6 of the 2013 "Determination of Solar Feed-in Tariff Premium", Draft Price Determination that the Current Premium Determination commenced on 27/1/2012 and is scheduled to expire on 30/6/2014 at a rate of 11.2cents per kwh. However the commission in their wisdom have decided to override this agreement and decided to reduce the figure to 9.8cents per kwh from 1/7/2013 to 31/12/2013. When I went to the expense of installing my pv system I was under the impression that the pricing was fixed for the agreed period?

I think that The Commission should maintain my rate at 11.2cents per kwh for the agreed period as with any "Normal" Business Agreement.
