



## WARNING NOTICE

Issued by the

**Essential Services Commission of South Australia ("the Commission")**

**on 6 April 2005**

Pursuant to section 63A of the *Electricity Act 1996* (SA) (the "Act"), warning is hereby given that the Commission will prosecute CHHWP for breaching section 15 of the Act, arising from CHHWP's conduct of electricity generation operations without a licence issued under Part 3 of the Act, at its wood-waste plant located on the Jubilee Highway East in Mt Gambier, South Australia ("the plant"), unless CHHWP:

1. Enters into a Network Connection Agreement, relating to the operations of the above plant, with the local Network Service Provider, ETSA Utilities, by 29 July 2005;
2. Takes appropriate action to ensure that a Safety and Technical Management Plan is prepared dealing with the matters set out in subregulation 31C(2) of the *Electricity (General) Regulations 1997* (SA), which plan must be provided to the Commission by 29 July 2005; and
3. Provides written assurance to the Commission by 29 July 2005, that it will not in the future contravene Part 3 of the Act.
