Regulatory Reporting – Important Dates Minor and Intermediate Water Retailers

PURPOSE

Minor and Intermediate Retailers have ongoing monitoring and reporting obligations in respect of three areas: Compliance Reporting, Operational Performance Reporting and Financial Reporting (including Price Monitoring).

This document gives a summary of the important dates applicable to Minor and Intermediate Water Retailers each year. Retailers should familiarise themselves with the following regulatory instruments which contain detailed information on reporting and compliance obligations.

A minor retailer means a retailer which provides retail services to 500 or fewer connections, with minor licensee having the same meaning. An intermediate retailer means a retailer which provides retail services to more than 500 but fewer than 50,000 connections, with intermediate licensee having the same meaning.
